Speaker, Nicola Quin - Head of Division,
Strategy and Support - Cancer Council Victoria
talked about the relationship that ACV/GARDS
had with Cancer Council Victoria and spoke
about CCV's work with mesothelioma cancers

- research and support programs. About High
Mortality Cancer's Alliance, established out of
concern for cancers with poor outcomes where
there has been little progress.

The Government's work in policy this year, including signing on to the National Strategic Plan for Asbestos Management and Awareness and in March the announcement of the establishment of a dedicated agency (Victorian Asbestos Eradication Agency) to prioritise the removal of asbestos in Government buildings in Victoria.

Wanting to see Government commit to a long term goal of removing all asbestos in the built environment (not just schools and government buildings)

Seeking government to consider robust responses to related occupational health risks, such as adopting WorkSafe Australia's updated list of deemed diseases, and monitoring and protecting other/emerging 'at risk' occupations.

Robyn Duffy, Coordinator Health Services at Latrobe City, talked about the Asbestos in the Home Removal kit, its great success in the community addressing a very real problem of domestic asbestos removal/exposure through not enough education and awareness — also helping to reduce illegal dumping of asbestos in our environment.

Steve Dodd Secretary of the Gippsland Trades and Labour Council, spoke of the role in transition of workers being made redundant over the closure of Hazelwood Power station.

Mark Richards CFMEU organiser, spoke of the closure of Hazelwood and how much asbestos still remains in Hazelwood and the future demolition of the site and remediation.

Vicki Hamilton OAM, CEO/Secretary of ACV/GARDS, spoke about the issues of imports into Australia – the Asbestos in the Home Removal Kit and the Government kit modelled from the kit in Gippsland (Domestic Asbestos Removal Kit) and what seems to be the shelving of the government kit and no real appetite by the Victorian State Government to address a real need for this in the community – addressing the very immediate dangers around domestic asbestos home renovations - still waiting on some real answers from this State Government.

Musician/Singers - Susan Parrish, Joe Omar and Phil Edwards, played some very soulful melodies such as Wind beneath my wings, Shelter, Annie's Song – what a great sound from a wonderful trio.

The Latrobe Valley Community Choir, had a strong presence singing - You'll never walk alone and You're the voice we thank the 12 choir members their conductor and key board player with helper Torben Jones

Bag piper – Richard Harris, piped some truly wonderful music out into the crowd and community it could be heard carrying in the distance.

Minister Russell Jones conducted an Ecumenical Service remembering those who had succumbed to asbestos, those who were suffering and their families – his own personal story of his father's asbestos disease brought a reality to those who thought it only touched some in the community – asbestos touches all families and from all walks of life.

A free Community BBQ with the compliments of Gippsland Trades and Labour Council – thank you to President Val Prokopiv this just topped a very touching and inspirational event where there was indeed a great deal of information sharing and brought together a great deal of companionship/comradery from the crowd. All those who attended realised from the days events what a scourge asbestos is in communities all over Australia and the world.




HAVE YOU PAID YOUR ACV/ GARDS MEMBERSHIP FEES? - PLEASE CHECK
